Welcome and review of agenda:

Chair Paul Rosenberg opened the meeting in asking Council members and guests to introduce themselves.

Review progress report from previous meeting:

No progress report was available from the June 26, 2012 meeting.

Division updates:

The reorganization of the department was briefly explained.

The council asked for licensing information as to the number of licensees and the passage percentage of master mechanic applicants taking the licensure exam. The information will be provided at the next meeting.

Credentialing revisions:

The department shared a draft of proposed revisions under chapter SPS 305, Licenses, Certifications and Registrations. The rule revisions focus on implementing the statutory provisions as affected by 2011 Wisconsin Act 146. The draft did not include revisions for the elevator inspector regarding the ASME removing itself out of the accreditation aspects; the department has determined that it is necessary for statutory changes in order to affect a change. The council passed a motion in favor of moving the draft onto the public hearing phase.

Scope of project:

The council also passed a motion recommending that the department utilize the 2013 edition of the ASME 17.1 standard in the update of chapter SPS 318.

Scope of project:

The department shared a draft of statutory revisions it is considering regarding chapter 101 subchapter VII, Elevators, Escalators, and Other Conveyances. Comments and suggestions concerning the potential revisions should be directed to Jeff Weigand or Jim Quast.

ASME A18.1

The council recommended that the following Wisconsin modifications for ASME A18.1 standard be eliminated:

- SPS 318.1802 (1) and (2); 318.1802 (7) (a) to (c); 318.1802 (8) (a) 1. to 4.; 318.1802 (8) (c); 318.1802 (9) (a) 1. to 3.; 318.1803 (3) (a) 1. to 4.; 318.1803 (3) (b);

The department is to provide further research on the following Wisconsin modifications for ASME A18.1 standard:

- SPS 318.1801 (3) references to ICC/ANS A117.1 and other referenced standards noted as "latest edition"; SPS 318.1802 (3) to (6); SPS 318.1802 (8) (a) 5.; SPS 318.1802 (9); SPS 318.1803 (2); SPS 318.1804 (1) and (2); SPS 318.1805; SPS 318.1806; SPS 318.1807
