Examination Results:

The Department of Safety and Professional Services will mail the exam results for the Statutes and Rules Exam to candidates within two weeks after the administration of the examination. Applicants must send the results of the National Home Inspector Examination to the Department when applicants have passed the examination.

Examination Review:

An applicant who fails either the Statutes and Rules Exam may request a review of that examination by filing a written request with the Department of Safety and Professional Services within 30 days of the date on which the examination results were mailed. Examination reviews are by appointment only. The time for review shall be limited to one hour. During the review, an applicant shall be provided with a copy of the questions and a copy of the applicant's answer sheet with the correct answers marked.

Evaluation and Fairness:

The content and process of these examinations and candidate performance statistics are regularly evaluated by the Department to assure that these examinations fairly and effectively assess competencies necessary to practice as a home inspector.

Record Retention:

Answer sheets, examination products and examiner evaluation documents for the Statutes and Rules Exam are retained for one year after the examination date.
